Grenache - fruity with a hint of allspice.

Sangiovese - fruity with mouth quenching acidity.

Tempranillo - savory with heraceous and meaty notes.

Syrah - savory with notes of white pepper, green olive, peach and cherry skin.

Cabernet Sauvignon - savory with heightened acidity, green bell pepper, black currant and pepper spice.

Tavel - savory and rich that is unusually dry, with lots of body and structure.

Provence - fruity and lean with fresh, crisp, dry and distinctive, salty minerality on the palate.

Mourvèdre - fruity and floral which can be full of red plums, cherries, dried herbs and even smoke.

Pinot Noir - delicately fruity with bright acidity, elegant and earthy.
