*SYRAH* - *savory with notes of white pepper, green olive, peach and cherry skin.*

*CABERNET SAUVIGNON* - *savory with heightened acidity, green bell pepper, black currant and pepper spice.*

*TAVEL* - *savory and rich that is unusually dry, with lots of body and structure.*

*PROVENCE* - *fruity and lean with fresh, crisp, dry and distinctive, salty minerality on the palate.*

*MOURVÈDRE* - *fruity and floral which can be full of red plums, cherries, dried herbs and even smoke.*

*PINOT NOIR* - *delicately fruity with bright acidity, elegant and earthy.*

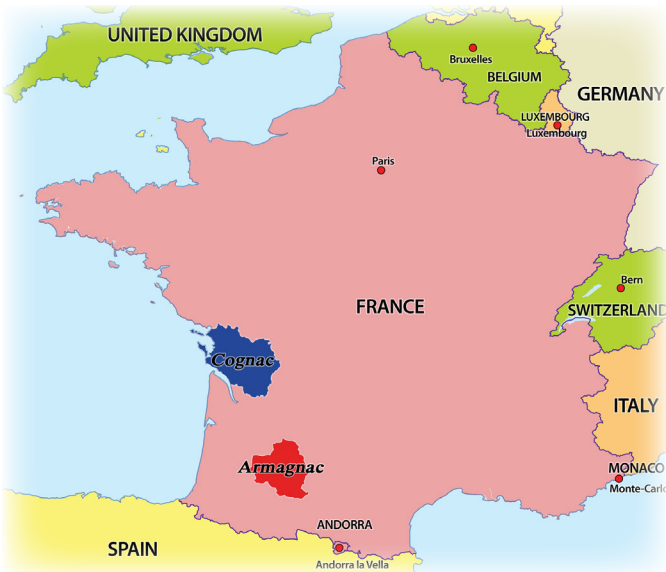
