*TEMPRANILLO - savory with heraceous and meaty notes.*

*SYRAH - savory with notes of white pepper, green olive, peach and cherry skin.*

*CABERNET SAUVIGNON - savory with heightened acidity, green bell pepper, black currant and pepper spice.*

*TAVEL - savory and rich that is unusually dry, with lots of body and structure.*

*PROVENCE - fruity and lean with fresh, crisp, dry and distinctive, salty minerality on the palate.*

*MOURVÈDRE - fruity and floral which can be full of red plums, cherries, dried herbs and even smoke.*

*PINOT NOIR - delicately fruity with bright acidity, elegant and earthy.*

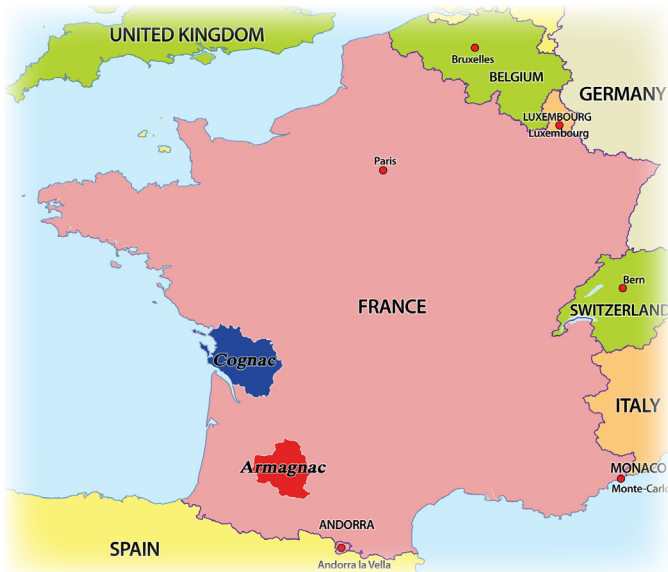
